REMINGTON MEDICAL RESORTS READY TO BREAK GROUND IN RICHARDSON

The corner of North Plano Road and East Lookout Drive in Richardson is the site for a new transitional care medical resort unlike any in the nation. Solely designed to serve guests on a short-term basis, Remington Medical Resorts will offer a new post acute rehabilitation and medical care option to patients and medical professionals.

“Many patients require further medical care or rehabilitation before going home, but are well enough to leave the hospital. No matter how comfortable, many of the traditional post-acute facilities don’t appeal to patients in need of only a few days or weeks of transitional care,” explains Ken Morgan, President of Remington Medical Resorts.

The management team of Remington Medical Resorts believes that its brand of professionalism, luxury, therapy and service will appeal to Metroplex patients and their physicians.

Designed by Mayse & Associates of Dallas, the \$13 million dollar, 66,000 square foot medical resort will have 90 private guest suites, each complete with private shower, refrigerator, flat-screen television, cable, and desk with wired and wireless Internet. Outside of their suite, guests may spend time in the library, living room with fireplace, Internet café, and coffee shop. Gourmet meals prepared by an executive chef may be ordered in the dining room, or called in by the guest for in-room dining service. As a final indulgence, guests may treat themselves to massages, manicures or facials on site.

Upon registering at Remington, guests become an integral part of their own treatment team. As a team, guests and Remington medical staff members develop personalized treatment plans. Teams will utilize two fully equipped rehabilitation gyms and a HydroWorx rehabilitation pool for aquatic therapy, with an underwater treadmill, camera and monitors to achieve maximum physical recovery in the least amount of time possible.

Recruiting exceptional medical professionals to guide each guest’s progress, and implementation of a high nurse/guest ratio are among Remington’s key strategies to medical success. Exceptional visionary leadership will also play a major role in implementing this new model of care, as Remington recruits for the CEO and Chief Clinical Officer for Richardson.

“Hiring the best healthcare and hospitality professionals in the Metroplex area is a challenge we welcome,” says Stephanie Morgan, Vice President of Clinical Services. “We believe that applicants will be attracted by a completely new model of transitional healthcare, and the opportunity to work in a beautiful new environment.”
